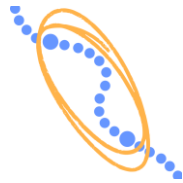
Glory Be

Mystery/Decade (x5)

Our Father, Hail Mary (x10), Glory Be, Fatima Prayer



Fatima Prayer: O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy.

There are four sets of rosary mysteries (also called decades). Each set contains 5 mysteries. If you are new to praying the rosary you may choose to pray one decade a day. See the chart below for the recommended days to pray each set.
